

# GTE- Delhi/NCR 2025 wraps up with quality visitor turnout



The garment industry has always played an important role in the industrial and economic development of our states of Delhi/NCR. The garment sector has seen rapid growth in the last few years and still holds tremendous potential for growth in today's era. Over the years, Delhi NCR has made rapid progress and is among the major garment hubs of the country. In fact, over the last decade, a number of integrated garment & knitting units, supported by world-class processing and printing, have come up in the region of Gurgaon, Faridabad, Noida, and Greater Noida. Keeping this in view, the Garment Technology Expo (GTE) was organised at India Expo Centre & Mart, Greater Noida.
